<b>OECD-Total</b>	The 36 OECD countries including Lithuania, unless otherwise specified.

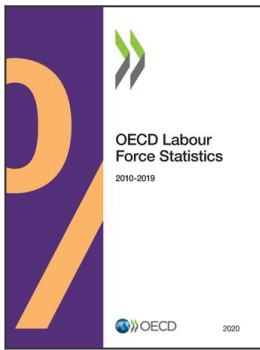
