

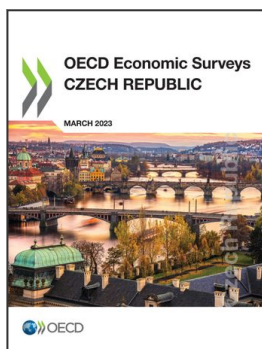
# Foreword
